

2019 Operating Budget Approved

At Grace's Annual Charge Conference on November 27, the Administrative Council approved the 2019 Operating Budget submitted by the Finance Committee. The budget totals \$746,181; an increase of only \$306 over the 2018 budget.

Our thanks to the various committees and ministry teams, the Administrative Council, the church staff, and Finance Committee for the ways they bring the ministries of Grace forward, while being mindful of costs at the same time.

Praying Our Way Forward - We Are One in Christ

A prayer vigil is being led by the Bishops of the United Methodist Church around the world, seeking unity in our church families as we move toward the special session of the General Conference on February 23-26, 2019. At this Conference, the church will determine requirements for people entering the clergy of the United Methodist Church or being joined in marriage, specifically as it relates to those of the LGBTQ community.

All United Methodists are invited to:

1. Engage in a weekly 24-hour fast, at the same time John Wesley, founder of Methodism did-- from Thursday after dinner to Friday mid-afternoon. Those with health issues that prevent them from fasting might consider fasting from social media, TV or emails.
2. Pause and pray for our church's mission and way forward daily for 4 minutes, from 2:23 through 2:26 am or pm, because the Conference will be held 2/23 through 2/26. You might want to set a daily alarm.
3. Pray using the weekly prayer calendar on the UMCPrays.org website through the end of February 2019. The calendar will give a prayer theme and list names of bishops and delegates to the Conference, and others involved in decision making, so that we can pray for them by name.

Prayer is the most significant and positive spiritual thing we can do at this important moment in the history of the United Methodist Church. Thank you for participating in this worldwide prayer initiative.
